- The wire which is coloured brown must be connected to the terminal which is marked with the letter L or coloured red.

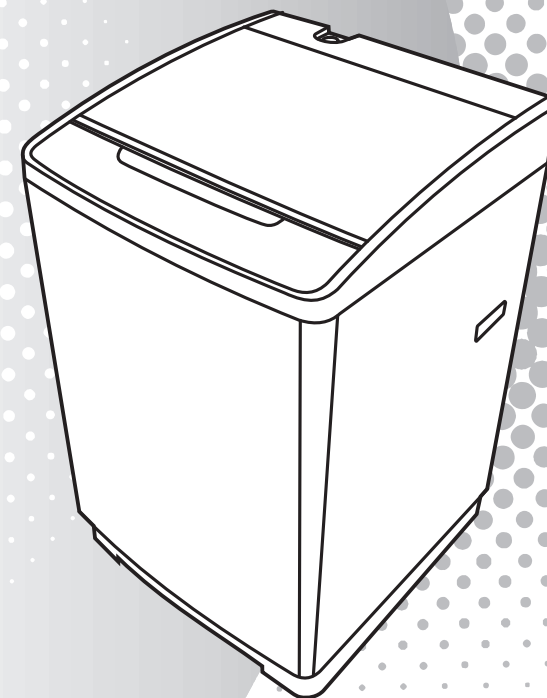

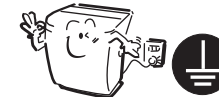

## **WARNING**

### For power plug and cord

This washing machine is equipped with a 3 pin plug which includes an earthing wire. This appliance must be earthed.



Electricity supply must be unplugged with dry hands. (Otherwise, this may cause electric shock.)



Damaged or losses wire or plug should not be used. (Otherwise electric shock, short circuit or fire may take place.)



Do not damage wire. Do not damage or alter the wire forcibly bend, pull twist or handle the wire. Beside, please do not put weigh on trap the wire. (Damage of wire may case electric shock or fire.)



### For tub and main unit

Keep child away from the washing spinning basket and do not place box or shelves next to the washing machine.

Children may fall into the basket resulting in injuries.



This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.



Dismantling, repair or alterations should only be carried out by professional technician as otherwise you may be subject to electric shock, may cause fire or get injured.



This washing machine is strictly prohibited to get close to the locations with candle, mosquito-repellent incense, dog-end or other kinds of open flame.

(To avoid injuries caused by the lock damage.)



## ⚠ WARNING

### For power plug and cord

- **Please use the single socket with special voltage and current matched with plug marked specification.**

The share of the same socket with other electric appliances may cause fire due to excessive.



- **Thoroughly wipe the power plug when dirt is adhering the prong or around the base of the prong.**

Failure to do so may cause a fire.



- **Do not pull the wire from the socket when unplugging the unit.**

To avoid electric shock or fire cause by short circuit may result.



- **Electricity supply must be unplugged with dry hands during maintenance and repair.**

Otherwise, electric leakage causing injuries may occur. If the power cord or supply cord is damaged, the manufacture or its service agent or similarly qualified person must replace it in order to avoid a hazard.



- **Please unplug the unit when not using the unit for a long period of time.**

Electric shock or leakage may occur due to deformation of plastic parts of the unit.



### For tub and main unit

- **Do not put your hand into the basket until it has stopped completely.**

Even when the spinning of the basket is slow, there is still a danger of being caught in the motion, resulting injuries. Particular attention should be paid when children are around.



- **Do not put your hand into the washing or spinning basket during the washing and rinsing process.**

Even when the spinning is slow, hands may be trapped by clothes. If necessarily, please press pause button, and put your hands into the basket after it has stopped completely.



### During use

- **Do not put water in direct contact with the unit during maintenance and repair.**

This may cause short circuit or electric shock.



- **Do not put gasoline, benzine, alcohol, thinner of fabrics with these stains into or near to the washing machine.**

To prevent fire or explosion which may cause injuries.



- **Washing machine should not be installed in humid place or in places exposed to wind and rain.**

Otherwise, electricity leak causing electric shock or fire may occur.



- **Keep hands and feet away from the bottom of the washing when it is motion.**

Ports in motion beneath the unit may cause injuries.



- **Do not stand on or put weight on the top of the unit.**

Otherwise, deformation and damage may result causing injuries.



- **Do not connect to the hot water supply, if use warm water, water of above 50°C should not be used for washing.**

Electric shock or leakage may occur due to deformation of plastic parts of the unit.



## ⚠ ATTENTION

- **Do not wash, rinse and spin the water proof fabric or cloth.**

Sleeping bag, raincoat, cover of skiing, utilities, bicycles, cars and motors. Otherwise may lead to injury by abnormal vibration during spinning or damage the washing machine, wall, floor and clothes.



- **Please turn off the water tap when not using the unit.**

To prevent damages caused by water leakage.



- **Clean washing machine**

Use soft clothing to wipe off the water or dirt on the surface of the washer.

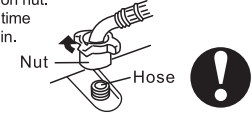


- **Do not spray water directly to the washer body.**

- **Detergent, propellant and other chemicals are not allowed to use to avoid the damages on the surface.**

- **Water supply hose should be tightly screwed to the unit.**

Failure to do so may result in water leakage. Used for a long period of time, the unit may result in water leakage caused by loosen union nut. So please check it in time and screw tightly again.



- **Check water supply hose connection by turning on the water before washing. To prevent damages caused by possible water leakage due to loosen screw or not tightly.**

- **The new hose-sets supplied with the appliance are to be used and that old hose-sets should not be reused.**

- **Do not block the ventilation openings on the bottom of washer by carpeting when the water is installed on a carpeting floor.**



## Care and Maintenance

### Clean lint filter (Lint Filter is easily destroyed parts)

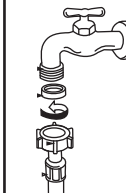
- Suggest clean it every week.



- 1 Take out the lint filter.
- 2 Pull out the scraps and wash the lint filter in the water.
- 3 Install the Filter (aim the frame claw to the groove below.)

### Clean hose filter

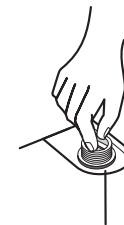
- Suggest clean it every 6 months.



- 1 Turn the nut of water supply hose counter clockwise, take down water hose.
- 2 Clean the crud with a toothbrush.
- 3 Install the clean water hose.

### Clean the water inlet Valve

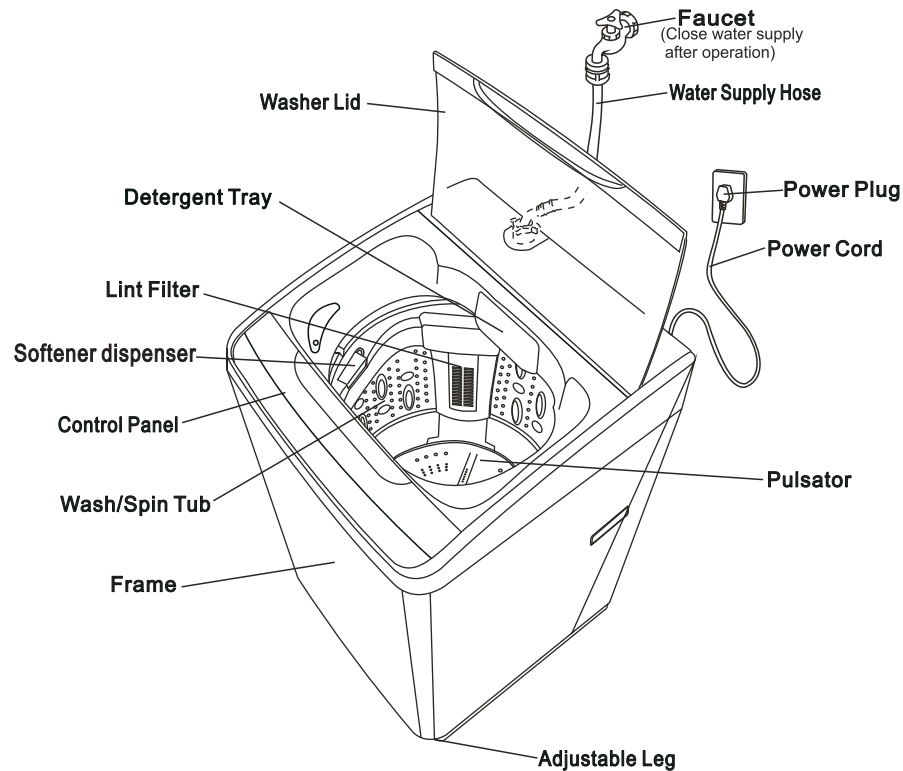
- Suggest clean it every 6 months.



#### Water Inlet

- After long time use, The water inlet mesh bag may be blocked with crud, please load off the water inlet hose, take out the water inlet mesh bag from the water inlet valve, clean the mesh bag, then assemble the mesh bag in the valve and load the water inlet hose.

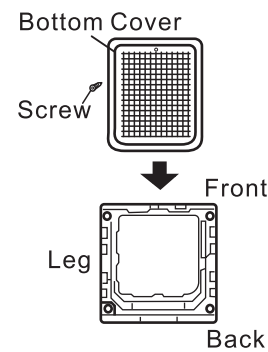

# Installation Instructions I

## Installing the Bottom Cover



- Put out the bottom cover and in the part bag's bolt.
- Gently lay down the back side of washer on a soft mat or cushion. (Be careful not to dent the Frame.)
- Insert the attached Bottom Cover into the hooks of Leg by straightly pushing until it reaches into the back hooks.
- Fasten the Bottom Cover with a screw.
- Gently set the washer upright.

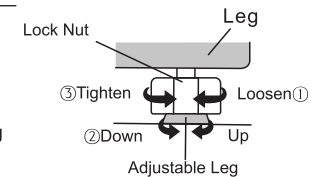
## Location of Washer



- Choose a dry location out of sunlight for the washer.
- Install the washer on a stable and level surface.

- Adjust the Adjustable Leg of washer if necessary to make the washer level as shown in the figure.

- The maximum permissible inclination of the supporting surface is 2°.

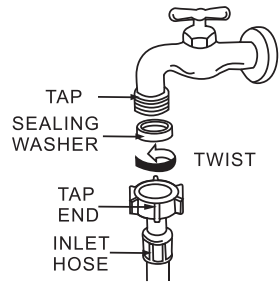


## CAUTIONS

- The washer must be installed so that its bottom opening will be not obstructed by the carpet etc.
- If the washer installed on the carpet floor or big stretch floor it may take big vibration.

# Installation Instructions II

## Connecting the Water Supply Hose

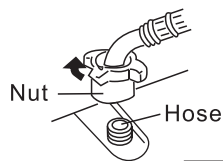


- 1** Check that sealing washers are firmly seated.
- 2** Attach the curved end of the hose to the inlet valve of the washing machine, tighten the coupling nuts securely by hand.
- 3** Attach straight end of the hose to the tap. Tighten the coupling nuts securely by hand.
- 4** Turn on the taps and check for leaks. Tighten the coupling nuts firmly if there is any leakage. If water pressure is strong, close the water tap completely then open it slightly.

### ! CAUTIONS

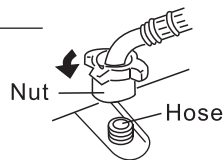
- Please make sure to keep the height of drain hose below 1000mm during washing, otherwise, the washer mightn't work properly.
- Do not use water which is hotter than 50°C.
- If the water supply hose does not match with your faucet, please consult your dealer.

## Installing Water Supply Hose to the Washer



- Turn the nut clockwise till the nut turned tight while golding the hose.

- Turn the nut counter clockwise after turning the faucet off when you want to detach the water supply hose.



### ! CAUTION

- Please make sure to keep the height of drain hose below 1000mm during washing, otherwise, the washer mightn't work properly.

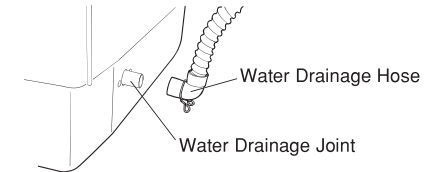

## For high draining level installation

## Installing the Drain Hose

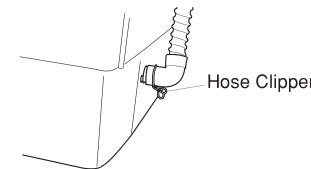

Connect the water drainage hose with the water drainage joint on the back of the body. Fully insert it into the position to avoid leakage.



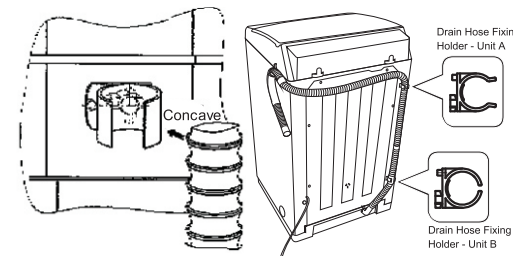
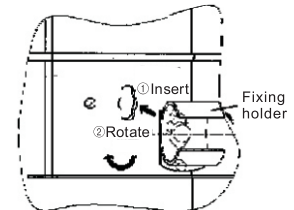

After the connection is completed. Please use hose clipper to clamp the water drainage hose to avoid falling off.



**3**

- ① Insert the fixing holder of water drainage hose into mounting hole.
- ② As shown below, rotate the fixed leg for 90 degree into the hole.



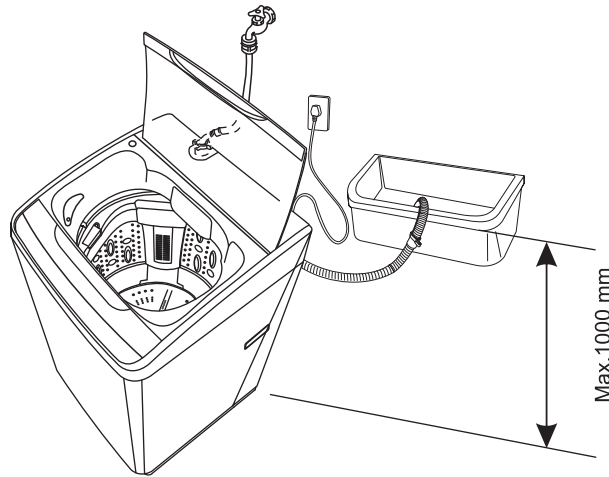

Pull the water drainage hose straight, concave to fix into the fixing holder of water drainage hose.

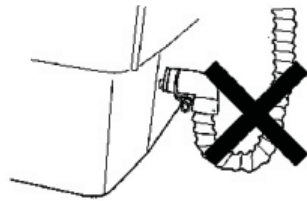
### ! CAUTION

- Please make sure to keep the height of drain hose below 1000mm during washing, otherwise, the washer mightn't work properly.

# Installation Instructions IV



- Please make sure to keep the height of drain hose below 1000mm during washing, otherwise, the washer mightn't work properly.



- Be sure not to install the water drainage hose at a position lower than water drainage joint, otherwise, it could lead to difficulties in water drainage.

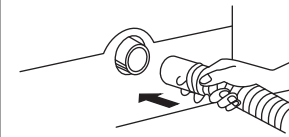
## ⚠ CAUTIONS

- Do not release the water drainage hose lest the water is splashed.
- Do not use extended water drainage hose.
- Do not immerse the tail of the U-shaped hose in the water.

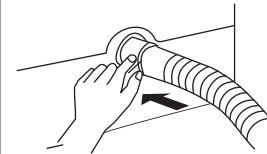
# Installation Instructions V

For low draining level installation

## Installing the Drain Hose



- 1 Pinching the two bands of the clamp on the drain hose, connect it to the pump (rear of cabinet) and fix the hose band.

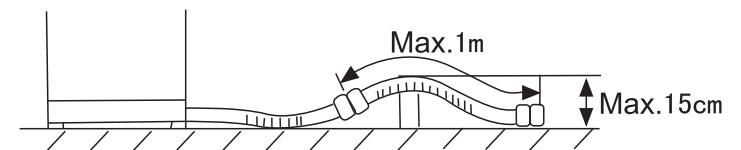


- 2 Pull the drain hose upward and fix it to the hose clip at the back cover of cabinet.

- 3 Hang the drain hose to the hole on right side of top frame when the washer is not working. And put the drain hose to drain spout when washer start working.

# Names and Function of Control Panel

### DETERGENT Indicators

- These are the spoon indications of the DETERGENT volume.
- Detailed operation Please refer to page 13.

### TIMER and SET Indicators

- This indicator shows remained time during washing. (E.g.) [Remaining time is 20 minutes] **20**
- This indicator shows water level. (E.g.) [Water level is 24L] **24 L**
- When abnormal conditions occur, the indicator will indicate warning. (E.g.) [Water does not flow] **E1**
- When setting **PROCESS**, the digital display indicates time or times. (E.g.) [Twice Water Saver Rinse] **2**
- This indicator shows when the washing is finished during presetting. (E.g.) [Finish washing 2 hours later] **2**

### START/PAUSE Button

- This button can be used to start the washer operation.
- This button can also be used to temporarily stop the washer operation. To restart the washer operation, press the **START/PAUSE** button again.

**NOTES:**

- This is not a cancel button.
- If you want to delete the End Buzzer, press the **START/PAUSE** button and hold down for about 4 seconds until beeping stops.

### WATER LEVEL Button

- You can choose the appropriate water level that matches the load size.
- Different water levels for washing rinsing optional. The blanket program can only choose the highest four grades of water levels, and the delicate program cannot choose the lowest two grades of water levels. Detailed operation please refer to Page 16.

### PROCESS and SET/VARIABLE WASH Button

- The **PROCESS** and **SET/VARIABLE WASH** button can be used to select **PRESET**, **SOAK**, **WASH** time, **RINSE** times, and **SPIN** time. For example to set Rinse times: Press **PROCESS** button till **RINSE** light flashes. Then press **SET/VARIABLE WASH** button to choose you wanted rinse times.
- Press **SET/VARIABLE WASH** button during washing, rinsing process, the wash water flow strength could be manually adjusted. The digital indicates "H0 (standard water flow), H1,H2,H3,H4 (stronger H4 is the strongest); L1,L2,L3,L4 (weaker, L4 is the weakest)." And this function could not be set for **DELICATE** or **BLANKET** course.

### PROGRAM Button

- To choose the washing course, press **PROGRAM** button. Press it and choose you need course, then the light above flashes.
- You can set **CHILD LOCK** function. Refer to **CHILD LOCK** function.

### POWER ON/OFF Button

- To turn the power on, press the **POWER ON/OFF**. When you want to turn off the power, press the **POWER ON/OFF** again. When washing has finished, the power will be turned off in 5 seconds automatically. (except Setting Remained water Draining function).

**NOTES:**

- If you want to change the wash course, turn the **POWER ON/OFF** off and then on it again.
- If you leave the washer turning on without starting the operation, the power will be turned off in 10 minutes by itself.

# Normal Usage

## 1 Preparation

- 1.1 Make sure to fit the Drain hose.
- 1.2 Connect the water supply hose to the faucet and turn the faucet on.
- 1.3 Plug the Power Cord into a socket.
- 1.4 Put clothes inside.

## 2 Press POWER ON/OFF button





## 3 Press START/PAUSE button

- Sensor tests the clothes weight automatically. (For NORMAL/CUSTOM/HEAVY DUTY) Auto choose the proper water power, water level, wash/spin time and rinse times.
- It is not available for the 2 lowest water levels. Need manually set if needed.

## 4 Close the washer lid

- The washer will alarm and stop working before spinning if the washer lid is not closed.

- You can use softener, pour the softener slowly so Softener Dispenser before washing.
- Too much detergent causes poor rinsing and too little detergent causes poor washing.







# How To Use Program and Process I

1. Preparation: Fit the Drain hose, turn the water supply faucet on, plug the Power plug into a socket, put clothes inside.
2. Press **POWER ON/OFF** button.
3. Press **PROGRAM** button to choose the course you need according to the clothes. Please refer to below chart for course choosing.

### PROGRAM CHOOSING GUIDE

Program	Water Power	Suitable clothes
NORMAL	Standard	Normal clothes
CUSTOM	Standard	Kinds of clothes
HEAVY DUTY	Strong	Dirty clothes like working coat
BLANKET	Blanket	Blanket or Bulky
DELICATE	Soft	Women underwear, articles with embroider
ECO-SPEEDY	Standard	Less dirty

4. Press **PROCESS** button to choose SOAK, WASH, SPIN time, RINSE times.

- **PRESET time indicating:** 0 → 1 → 2... → 5 → 6... → 24 hours  
  
 (Except the **DELICATE** program).
- **SOAK time indicating:** 0 → 10 → 20 → ... → 30 → 40 minutes  
  
 (This function is only valid for **DELICATE/BLANKET** program).
- **WASH time indicating:** 0 → 1 → 2 → ... → 19 → 20 minutes  

- **RINSE times indicating:** 0 → 1 → 2 → 3 → 4  

- **SPIN times indicating:** 0 → 1 → 2 → ... → 8 → 9 minutes  
  
 (Except the **DELICATE** program).  
 0 → 1 → 2 → 3 minutes (For **DELICATE** program).  


5. Press **WATER LEVEL** button to choose proper water level and then put detergent.
6. Press **START/PAUSE** button.
7. Close the washer lid.
  - If you want to change **PROGRAM** or **PROCESS** during operation, please switch off power, restart power and choose your needed course you need.

## The Preparation of Laundry Before Washing

- Make sure that nothing remained in pocket. (Pin, coin or something like possibly damage clothes or washing machine, and the extra noise occurred may cause trouble to washing machine).
- Wool items like women underwear, articles with embroider, nylon etc, should be placed in laundry net for extra protection.
- Close the fastener and tie loose laces.
- Brush the dirty parts like dust and sand.
- Put light clothes down. Please pause operation and put it into water when it floats up.
- Please separate washing white clothes from coloured clothes, coats from underwear.

# Various Functions

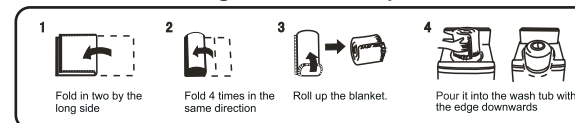
## BLANKET

1. Press POWER ON/OFF on and put the drainage hose.
2. Turn the faucet on and press PROGRAM button till BLANKET light on.
3. Dissolve the detergent with around 5L warm water (about 30°C), pour it into the tub of the washing machine.

4. Fold up the blanket as the method showed in the figures below and pour it into the washing tub.

5. Press START/PAUSE button.

6. Close the washer lid.



## WATER LEVEL SETTING

Washing with low level water and rinsing with high level water will help more clean washing and completely rinsing.

## METHOD OF SETTING

Press **WASH** button to set wash time, press **WATER LEVEL** button to set water level for wash, press **RINSE** button to set rinse times. Then press **WATER LEVEL** to set water level for rinse, press **SPIN** button to set spin times, press **START/PAUSE** button to start. By this, wash and rinse will work according to the water levels set separately.

## TWO CLEAN STEPS FUNCTION

The washer will start washing when water to the level below 2 levels as set. By this, the washer starts working with more density of detergent.

- This function won't be effected when select level 1 or level 2 water, and DELICATE or BLANKET course.
- When SOAK is selected, this function will not be effected after soaking.

## REMEMBER FUNCTION

When select **NORMAL**, **CUSTOM** or **HEAVY DUTY**, 15 seconds after starting, the washer will remember this program and starts same next time working.

- This function is not available for DELICATE/BLANKET course.
- **WATER LEVEL**, **SOAK** will not be remembered.
- Normal, heavy duty program, no memory of wash, rinse, spin process of the artificial setting.
- The memory will be lost if pull out the plug.

## CHILD LOCK FUNCTION

The Washer will stop working automatically and alarm if washer lid opened 5 seconds during operation.

**Method of Child Lock Set:**

Switch on **POWER ON/OFF** button, press **PROGRAM** button for 4 seconds till Buzzer sounds. To restore it, repeat above or pull out the plug.

If you set the Child Lock function, the other buttons do not respond.

## DELETE THE END BUZZER

Press **POWER ON/OFF** button to switch on the power, and press **START/PAUSE** button for 4 seconds till a sound from buzzer. To restore it, repeat above or pull out the plug.

# Trouble Shooting Guide

When the following problems occur, the microcomputer will detect the abnormal condition and an electronic buzzer sounds for approximately 10 seconds and the indicators flash as shown below. At the same time, the washer stops operation.

## NOTES:

- The trouble indicators can be released by pressing the **START/PAUSE** button once if you want to release the emergency stop.  
Then press the **START/PAUSE** button again to restart the operation.

# No Trouble Conditions

- 1** During Washing or Rinsing, still there is Water in letting. This is possibly automatic water adding due to water level decrease.
- 2** Spin tub turns or stops timely at the beginning of spinning. This is intermittent spinning for better spin effect.
- 3** Water is letting and rinsing sometimes during spinning. This is automatic lean-correction due to clothe is not equally inside.
- 4** There is sound like water flow after spinning. This is the sound of balance liquid in Balance ring. It is for reducing vibration of spinning.
- 5** Control panel keeps warm after power off, this is caused by Remembering circuitry working.
- 6** Power off during working and the washer could not continue working. should set the program again.

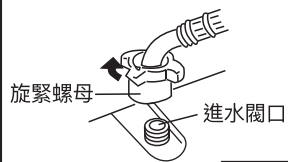

### 洗衣要領

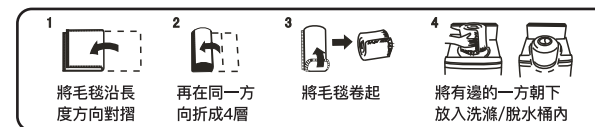
- 確保衣服口袋內沒有物品。(如釘子、硬幣等可能損傷衣服或洗衣機，產生額外的噪音或使洗衣機發生故障的東西。)
- 將衣服翻過來洗，這樣洗滌過程中產生的線屑不會附著在衣服表面。
- 當洗精細織物時，如女性內衣、飾有花邊的物品、尼龍和薄化織衣料等，應將其放入洗滌用網套中。
- 緊衣服上鬆的帶子並拉上拉鏈，扣好鈕扣。
- 洗滌前先去除衣物上的泥土和沙子。建議在洗較臟的外套前用刷子先洗刷一下。
- 易浮於水面之上的衣物請放入水底，另外，浮上來時請暫停並將其投入洗滌液中。
- 請將厚物與薄物分開洗滌，有色衣物與白色衣物分開洗滌，外衣與內衣、毛巾等分開洗滌。

# 並非故障的情況

- 1 洗滌或漂洗時有時有進水現象，這是水位下降而進行的自動補水。
- 2 在脫水開始時，脫水桶時停時轉，這是為達到更好的脫水效果而設計的間歇脫水。
- 3 脫水中途有時出現漂洗現象，這是由於脫水時衣物偏置，而自動進行的脫偏糾正。
- 4 脫水結束後，有水殘留的聲音，這是為了降低脫水振動而設計的平衡環內平衡液的流動聲。
- 5 在運轉後關掉『電源開/關』，控制板局部仍可以感覺到輕微發熱，這是由於記憶電路電子部件的發熱造成的。
- 6 程序運行中停電，來電後不能繼續運行，請重新設定。
